Whereas, there are currently 26,500 people on the waitlist for long-term care, and that number is expected to double in the next six years..

Whereas, long-term care homes require stable and predictable funding each year to help pay for rising cost of operations, provide quality care and invest in more beds.

Therefore: We the undersigned, call on the Legislative Assembly of Ontario to move quickly to pass Bill 110, *the Long-Term Care Homes Amendment Act, 2017*, and ensure that funding for food and utilities reflect changes in the cost of living.
